

Planting instructions for Bio PLUS+ fruit trees

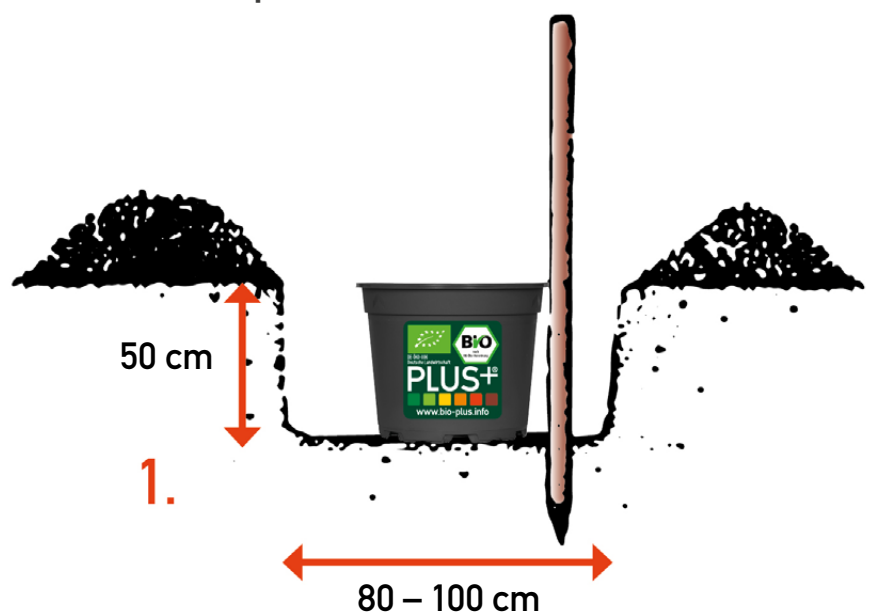


Our growers produce all Bio Plus+ fruit trees in containers. Therefore, they can be planted in the garden all year round. During frost or periods with very hot summer temperatures the trees should wait a bit before planting. They can be kept a while in the nursery pot.

When it is time to plant the tree in the garden, just simply place the nursery pot in a bucket with water to really soak up properly.

Now, the right location in the garden needs to be found. Please remember and check, how tall the tree will be grown when mature. Accordingly, you will need enough distance to the neighbour, the terrace or the sand box for the kids.

1. The planting hole needs to have a slightly larger diameter than the original root ball. Under no circumstances, don't plant the young tree too deep. Simply take the same height as in the nursery pot. Place a wooden pole into the planting hole and batter it down before placing the tree into the hole. After planting attach the tree to the pole.

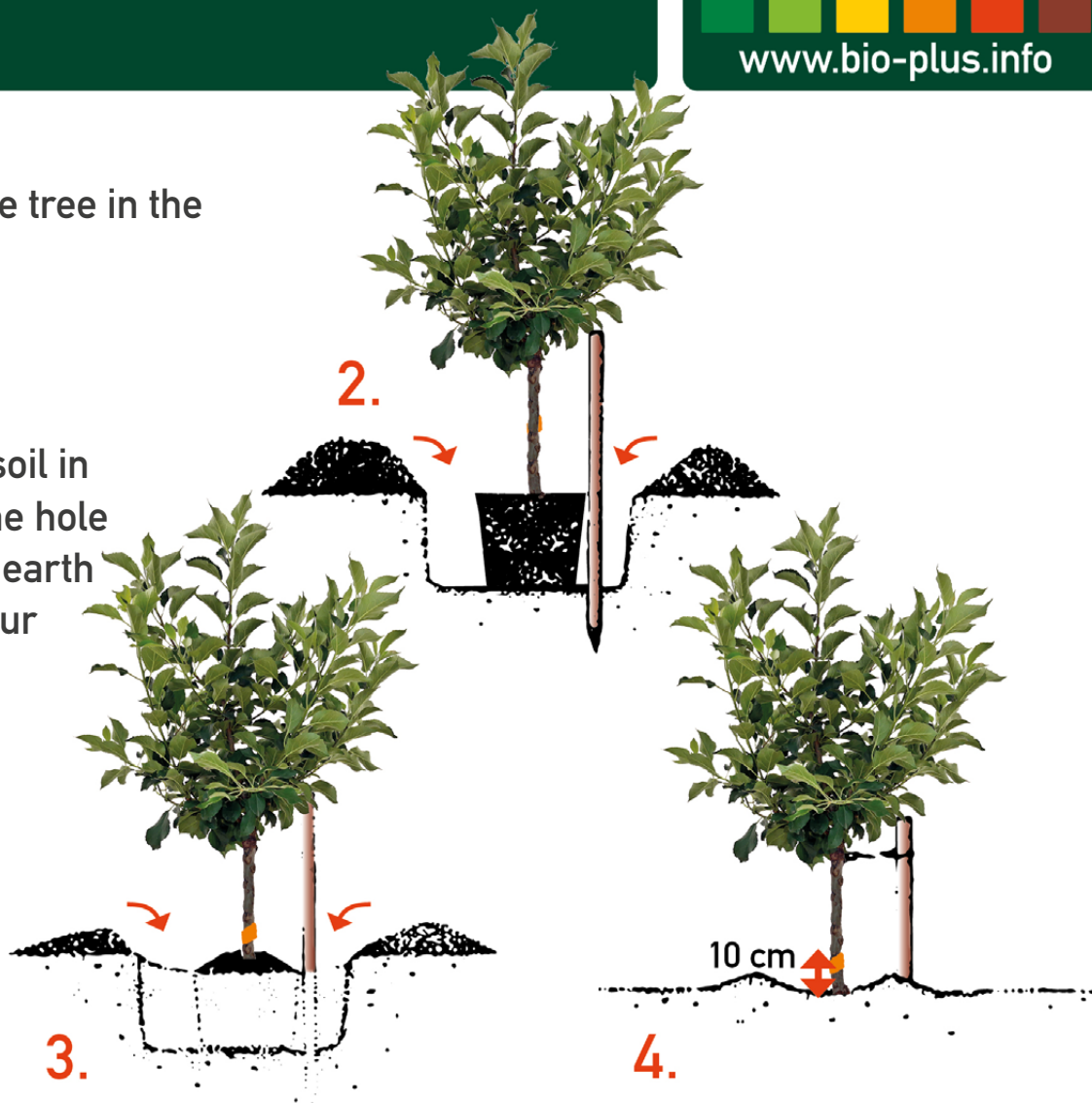

2. Now, place the tree in the planting hole.

3. Then, fill the soil in and around the hole and tread the earth firmly with your feet.



4. As the last step, fix the tree to the wooden pole. Now, the tree can grow. Often, one can see the grafting point very well. Don't cover it with soil. Rather keep it 10 cm above ground. Construct a low earth wall around the stem as a dam. The irrigation water can't run off, but can seep down directly to the roots. In the first couple of years the area near to the trunk of the tree should not be covered by grass or weed. Otherwise, the tree will not receive enough water and nutrients. Distribute bark thinly around the planting disc. Thus, there will not be any obstacles to an optimal growth.
